On March 6, the International Women's Day Rally in Tokyo was held at the Bunkyo Community Center. As in the previous year, to prevent COVID-19 infection, we disinfected the room before use, asked the participants to wear masks, and ventilated the room during breaks. According to the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare, 90,000 people have been laid off or hired off, but the actual number must be much higher, and many of them are women working in the restaurant business and retail service industries.
